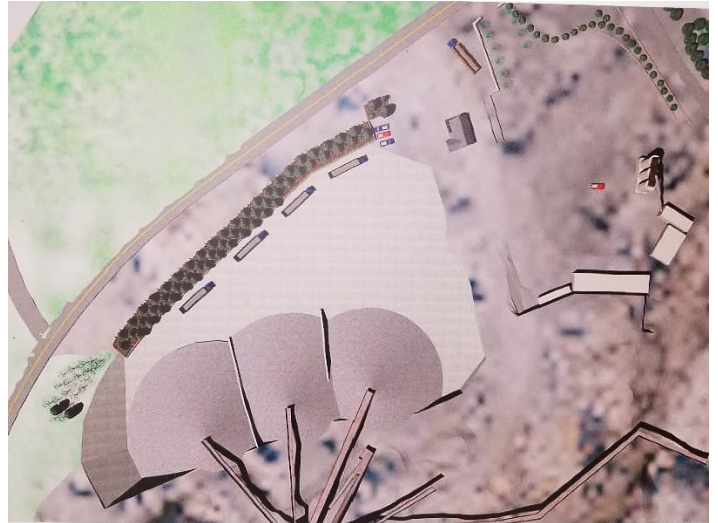
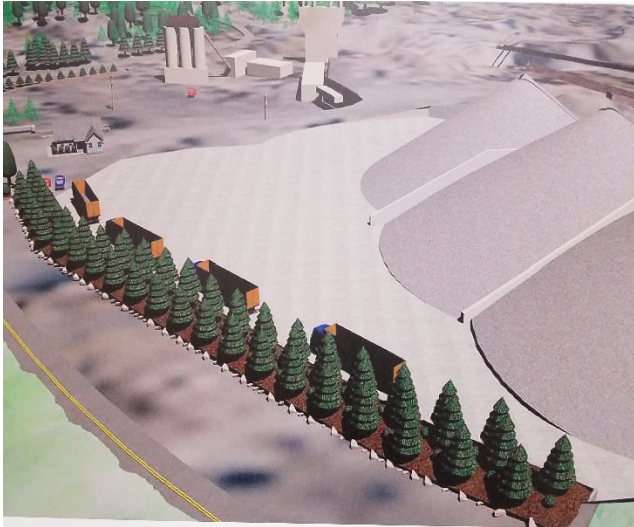


Visualizing the Future at Pleasant Valley

Since acquiring the Pleasant Valley location from the Arborio family in 2012, the site has been in a constant state of positive change. We have re-located ramps to improve efficiencies, upgraded virtually all of the hauling and loading equipment, and replaced the secondary and finish crushing equipment and structures. The site has essentially been rebuilt.

Now we are tackling the landscape itself, including obtaining town and NYSDEC approvals to construct a sizeable landscaped berm in place of enormous stockpiles of aggregate along the roadway. We will also drill and blast 60,000 tons of material to improve the site. When finished, a newly cleared area adjacent to North Avenue will have a natural-looking vegetated berm planted with various native species.



This project will make the site safer and more efficient for construction traffic and the traveling public, shield our neighbors from noise and dust, create a visually appealing landscape, and help to continue the strong community relationships that the Arborio family started in Pleasant Valley in 1937. This site enhancement is part of the environmental stewardship and community service ethic that Peckham Industries strives to incorporate in all its locations.
