### **To All Valued Customers/Drivers:**

Peckham Industries, Inc. holds safety as a core value and is committed to the safety and well being of our employees and customers. To that end, we expect that the following rules and actions will be adhered to while at all Peckham operations and job sites:

1. All trucks entering the property **must** have a working back-up alarm.
2. All drivers **must** remain in their trucks while loading, otherwise you will **not** be loaded.
3. While being loaded with asphalt, the driver **must** remain in the cab, with the windows up.
4. All drivers **must** wear hard hats, vests, and proper PPE any time while outside their truck.
5. Tarp racks must be used to access the truck bed, climbing on the side of the truck is prohibited.
6. Observe signs identifying site specific hazards at each location, including speed limits.
7. Drivers **must** identify themselves to review loading procedures and/or site specific safety rules.

Please be advised that the use of fuel oil in truck beds is prohibited on Peckham Industries Inc. property. **Failure to comply can result in a fine to the truck driver of up to \$25,000 by State/local Environmental Agencies.**

### **COVID-19**

1. Masks must be worn at all times while outside your truck.
2. Socially distancing of at least 6' is required while outside your truck.
3. Admittance into scale houses, offices, control rooms, etc. is not allowed unless approved by Peckham management.
4. Follow any specific local or State orders in place.

You are a valued partner in our success, please help us remain safe and healthy by following these rules. Remember, be a responsible member of our community by obeying all local traffic rules and regulations, and refrain from using engine brakes or air horns in residential areas.

Finally, your cooperation is expected, and any violations of the above rules will be dealt with accordingly, including removal from service. We trust that you will understand and respect these requests; we are in this together and look forward to working with you safely.
